



Financial Aid Process
For Blessed Sacrament Huguenot Catholic School Funds,
Diocesan McMahon Parater Foundation Funds and,
Diocesan Increased Offertory Funds
Assistance for 2012-2013 School Year

There are 3 sources of Financial Aid:

1. The Catholic Diocese of Richmond has allocated funds from the McMahon Parater Foundation for Education (MPFE) for tuition assistance for ALL qualified students.
2. The Catholic Diocese of Richmond has allocated funds from the Increased Offertory Program for Catholic students who qualify for MPFE for the 2012-2013 school year.
3. Blessed Sacrament Huguenot has allocated a limited amount of funds for financial aid. FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial needs analysis for BSH for the upcoming 2012-2013 school year and determining need for aid. **All families seeking financial aid must complete a FACTS application on line.**

Applications AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION for tuition assistance from MPFE, Increase Offertory and BSH must be received by FACTS by March 1, 2012 or by July 1, 2012 for those who have business income and/or are new families to BSH.

There is only one way to apply for school and diocesan financial aid:

- Applicants need to go on line at www.factstuitionaid.com

The following information is required for FACTS to process your application:

1. Complete online or paper application
2. Copies of your 2010 or 2011 tax return including all schedules – K-1's, C, etc.
3. Copies of your 2011 W2 for both you and your spouse
4. Copies of your supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families.
5. Send the **supporting documents** to FACTS to arrive by March 1, 2012 by either:

Award letters from Blessed Sacrament Huguenot will be mailed to eligible families for Blessed Sacrament Huguenot assistance in late May and entered on final copy of Enrollment Agreement. Award letters from the Diocese will be mailed to eligible families for Diocesan McMahon Parater Foundation and Increased Offertory Funds.
